## Swim21 Coordinator Required

The Swim21 coordinator role is at the heart of the committees work. Our annual submission to Swim21 includes a comprehensive file of all courses attended and certificates awarded to our Coaches, Teachers and other key roles. It also includes our annual club and staff development plans.

### Why is Swim21 important?

We are a Swim21 accredited Teaching Club. This is a quality mark on the standard of Teaching and Coaching that we provide at Bicester Blue Fins. It provides us access to bursaries for the professional development of our Coaches and Teachers. Without this we either undermine our standards or our costs would go up.

### What is required of the Swim21 Coordinator?

The primary duties of the Swim21 Coordinator are to:

- Liaise with the Regional Development Officer on all Swim21 matters
- Organise and oversee the audit and action planning stages of the Swim21 process within the club with the support of the whole Committee
- Ensure that Club members are informed of Swim21 courses and seminars

While some background in swimming is helpful in this role it is not essential. Estelle has kindly indicated that she would be happy to spend some time handing over the role and the Swim21 file to any newcomer.
