PROMOTERS CONDITIONS

Session Details	Entry on to Poolside from 8.15am. Session 1 – Warm-up 8.25am – 9.25am Competition starts at 9.30am Session 2 – Warm-up TBA with cards Competition starts at TBA – (Time will be noted on Swimmers Cards) ** Coaches are responsible and must supervise swimmers during warm up & during both sessions.
Competition	The Competition is open to amateur swimmers as defined by the ASA Laws:
Age	Age is at the 10th July, 2010 for the following age group: Girls & Boys: 9 years 10 years 11 years 12 years 13 years 14 years 15 years/over 100m events for 9yr old swimmers are not permitted, except 4x25m Individual Medley - Sept 2009 ASA Guidelines
Entries	Entries must be made on the Individual Entry Forms attached, indicating preferred events. Submitted times must be shown for each event entry and will be used for seeding purposes. Qualification times must be personal best times and fall within the attached table in the respective Age Groups for Consideration for Entry. Clubs are to complete and return Entry Summary Sheets along with a single cheque when submitting Entries. In order to ensure that we have appropriate officials and helpers available on the day, entry for swimmers is offered first to swimmers whose parents/guardians assist in an official capacity and then to swimmers on a first come first served basis . Numbers will only be limited to enable the gala to meet licensing requirements and will be at the promoter's discretion.
Late Entries	Applications for entry must be correctly submitted by the specified date. Entries received without payment or incorrectly completed may be rejected.
Posting Cards	Cards to be posted before the beginning of each warm up. Failure to comply could result in exclusion from the event.
Warm-up	Warm up details as noted above. Warm up procedures will be listed at either end of the pool. Diving is only permitted in designated sprint lanes.
Competing	It is the responsibility of the Team Manager and Coaches to ensure that their competitors report to the Marshalling Stewards in time for the start of their race.
Start	To maintain the scheduled timing of events all starts will be over the top, except backstroke races.
Seeding of Heats	Heats will be swum fully integrated and in ascending time order.
Winners	All events are HEAT DECLARED WINNER.

Individual Heat Winners	All individual heat winners will receive a novelty prize.
Awards	<p>Individual medals for the first 6 places for each of the 9 & 10 year Age Groups and then for the first 3 each of the remaining Age Groups.</p> <p>Any swimmer who swims equal to or faster than the upper time limit will not be eligible for medals or points, but will be presented with a "Speeding Ticket" recording the time achieved.</p> <p>Awards may be collected from the designated collection point when results are posted.</p>
Points	<p>Points will be awarded on the basis of 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 & 1 for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th places in all individual Heat Declared Winner.</p> <p>Top club shall be made on the same basis as the age groups.</p> <p>Note in the event of tied places "the average points" will be given for the tied swimmers, i.e. if first place is tied then both 1st & 2nd will receive 7.5 points and third placed swimmer will receive 6 points.</p>
Results	Results will be emailed to club's nominated person. Results will also be available to download from Bletchley & District Website – www.bletchleyswim.com
Trophies	<p>Trophies will be presented to the TOP BOY and TOP GIRL of the meet. This will be a perpetual trophy with permanent awards also being present.</p> <p>A trophy will be presented to a visiting Club with the highest overall points score at the end of the meet. This will be perpetual trophy with a permanent award also presented.</p> <p>In the event of a tie, the trophy will be awarded on the highest number of first places, then second places etc.</p> <p>ALL trophies will be engraved by the promoter and therefore must be returned to the promoter by the 1st June, 2010.</p>
Admissions	The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.
Health & Safety	For Health and Safety reasons at the end of each event swimmers must remain in their lanes in the pool until released by the referee.
Data Protection	DATA PROTECTION ACT 1984 – Personal information submitted to this meet is held on a data base and consent is therefore assumed to hold and disclose this information as necessary.
Miscellaneous	Anything not covered in the above conditions and associated literature will be at the discretion of the promoter/referee, subject to ASA Laws.
